<sup>7</sup> Norway resettled 150 Syrians from Turkey since 4 April 2016 by applying the standard operating procedures for resettlement agreed with Turkey in the ambit of the 1:1 scheme. The number of resettlements to Norway in the context of the 1:1 scheme is not counted against returns of Syrians from Greece.
